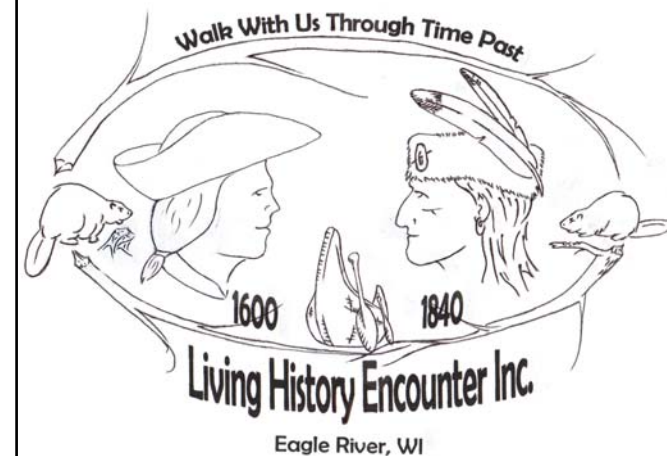

Historical material is presented by professional Historical Interpreters who prepare accurate demonstrations, camp settings and historical materials.

Interpreters achieve their skills through years of personal research and, in many cases, actually living the segments of history they portray. Interpreters are screened through an audition process for the accuracy of their information, historical materials and presentation methods.
